

THE HON'BLE SMT JUSTICE V. SUJATHA

Writ Petition No.19403 of 2023

ORDER:

The Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed seeking to declare the action of the respondent authorities in interfering with manufacture, sale and marketing of Bio-products of petitioner company and the 2nd respondent issued Memo No. PP.II(1)2085/2005, dated 21.01.2006 and consequential letter No. No. PP.II(1)2085/2005, dated 21.01.2006 as illegal and arbitrary.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has brought to the notice of this Court that in identical situations, the High Court of Judicature at Hyderabad has disposed of the Writ Petition No.25293 of 2014 and batch which fact was also not disputed by the respondents.

3. In view of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the Writ Petition is disposed of in terms of the orders of the High Court of Judicature at Hyderabad in Writ Petition No.25293 of 2014 and batch, dated 10.07.2015.
