Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents Nos.2 to 3 highhandedly trying to demolish the structures in Plot No.39 & 38 in Sy.No.200-1 A, situated in Gudarevupalle village, Piler Mandal, Annamayya District respectively, without adhere the produce under law as arbitrary, illegal, contrary to the well established legal principles apart from being violative of fundamental and constitutional rights guaranteed us under Articles 14,19,21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India. Consequently direct the respondents, more particularly respondents Nos.2 to 3 not to demolish the structures in Plot No.39 and 38 in Sy.No.200-1A, situated in Gudarevupalle village, Piler Mandal, Annamayya District, without following due process of law.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents 2 and 3 not to demolish the structures in Plot No.39 & 38 in Sy.No.200-1A, situated in Gudarevupalle village, Piler Mandal, Annamayya District respectively, without following due process of law, pending disposal of WP.No.19423 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.
