Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent particularly 3rd respondent in threatening to demolish the under constructed house in respect of property in an extent of 213 sq.yards covering plot Nos.45 Part and 46 in Sy.No.200/1A of Gudarevupalle Revenue Village, Piler Mandal, Annamayya District without adhering due procedure under law as illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional and violative of principles of natural justice and consequently direct the respondents not to demolish the under constructed house in respect of property in an extent of 213 sq.yards covering plot Nos.45 Part and 46 in Sy.No.200/1A of Gudarevupalle Revenue Village, Piler Mandal, Annamayya District.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to demolish the under constructed house in respect of property in an extent of 213 sq.yards covering plot Nos.45 Part and 46 in sy.No.200/ IA of Gudarevupalle Revenue Village, Piler Mandal, Annamayya District, pending disposal of the Writ Petition No.19425 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.
