Vijaya Bhaskar, learned Standing Counsel takes notice for R.5 The petitioner Institution is affiliated to the respondent University and is recognized by the NCTE. The 2nd respondent Council had issued admission notification for web-counselling for EdCET-2022 on 21.10.2022. As per the said notification, the web option for the students was scheduled from 01.11.2022 to 3.11.2022. However, the for the reasons best not known, the said notification did not fructify and the schedule of counseling had been postponed from time to time. The 5th respondent had issued a show cause notice pointing out certain deficiencies and sought the explanation from the petitioner Institution. Thereafter the petitioner Institution had submitted	

		explanation. The very issuance of show cause notice is bad in law and against the A.P. Universities Act in as much by that time, the notification for admission had already been issued by the 2nd respondent Council. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner(s) and perused the material available on record. In view of the above facts and circumstances of the case, the respondents are directed to display the name of the petitioner Institution in the website forthwith enabling it to participate in the ongoing counseling. The petitioner Institution is also directed to comply with the deficiencies pointed out by the respondents, if any, within a period of one month from today.
