Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that in similar circumstances, this Court granted an interim order dated 24.07.2023 in W.P.No.18253 of 2023 and requested to pass a similar order in this writ petition also. The interim order dated 24.07.2023 passed in W.P.No.18253 of 2023 is as follows: “The counsel for the petitioner(s) has brought to the notice of this Court that in identical circumstances, similar commission agents have filed W.P.NO.13346 of 2023 wherein this Court has passed an interim order directing the respondents not to take any coercive steps against the petitioner in any manner pursuant to the Memo No.AGC01-MKTGOPMIS/79/2023, dated 16.04.2023, issued by the 1st respondent for a period of four weeks. In view of the fact that, under similar circumstances an interim order is passed by this Court in W.P.No.13346 of 2023, this Court feels it appropriate to pass an interim order as follows: There shall be an interim direction directing the respondent Nos.4 and 5, not to take any coercive steps against the petitioners in any manner pursuant to the Memo No.AGCO01-MKTGOPMIS/79/2023, dated 16.04.2023, issued by the 1st respondent for a period of four weeks.”	

		Hence, in view of the aforesaid order, this Court is inclined to pass a similar order in this writ petition also. Therefore, there shall be an interim direction directing the respondent Nos.4 and 5, not to take any coercive steps against the petitioners in any manner pursuant to the Memo No.AGC01-MKTGOPMIS/79/2023, dated 16.04.2023, issued by the 1st respondent for a period of four weeks.
