ORDER:

This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India with the following prayer for:

“...pleased to issue an order Or proceeding, Writ, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action in the 4th Respondent in interfering with the petitioner's life and personal liberty, inflicting threats to ruin petitioner's life by calling him to the police station, preassuring the petitioner to settle with the respondents 5 to 7 herein as as illegal, arbitrary, Violative of Art. 14 and Art. 21 of the Constitution of India and to pass....”

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri V. Farook, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home for the respondents.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the police are calling the petitioner to the police station, in the absence of any crime registered and pressurizing the petitioner to settle the civil disputes in between the petitioner and the unofficial respondents. Learned counsel would further submit that a direction may be given to the police.
4. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, on written instructions would submit that the police are not interfering in the civil disputes between petitioner and the unofficial respondents.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that recording the same, the petition may be disposed of.

6. Recording the above said submissions, the Writ Petition is disposed of. However, the police are directed not to interfere in the civil disputes between the petitioner and the unofficial respondent, except under due procedure of law. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
