

**THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE RAVI CHEEMALAPATI**

**WRIT PETITION NO.19868 OF 2023**

**ORDER:**

The present Writ Petition is filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking the following relief:

*".....to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the Respondents in not releasing the funds amounting Rs.2,54,377/- to the petitioner under SDF Grant towards cost of the material supplied by the petitioner for the works*

*1) Construction of CC road and Drain at Narasapuram limits. as being illegal, arbitrary and violative of provisions of the Andhra Pradesh Panchayat Raj Act 1994 and UnConstitutional and consequently direct the respondents to release funds amounting Rs.2,54,377/- to the petitioner under SDF Grants towards cost of the material supplied by the petitioner for the works*

*1.) Construction of CC road and Drain at Narasapuram limits and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case....."*

2. Heard Sri G. Prasanthi, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleaders for Panchayat Raj and Finance & Planning.

3. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Panchayat Raj, on written instructions dated 10.08.2023, submitted

that, the bill will be generated vide CFMS No.2023-1232481 for the above work and bill has been submitted to PAO and sought some time for payment. He also submitted that, in similar set of facts this Court passed Order dated 28.06.2022 in W.P.No.17411 of 2022 wherein granted six (06) weeks' time for payment and accordingly, prayed to consider in the same lines.

4. To the said submission, learned counsel for the petitioner reported no objection.

5. Taking into consideration the submissions of both the learned counsel, this Writ Petition is also **disposed of**, at the admission stage, in terms of the orders passed in W.P.No.17411 of 2022, dated 28.01.2022.

Accordingly, the respondents are directed to pay the net amount to the petitioner at the earliest, and at any rate, within a period of six (06) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

There shall be no orders as to costs.

Miscellaneous applications, pending if any, shall stand closed.
