7.	07.12.2023	<u>SRS,J</u> <u>W.P.No.20032 of 2023</u> This writ petition is filed to declare the action of the respondents in changing the plan by diverting the drainage canal taking curve to 20 feet in from of the petitioner's house bearing door No.18-1-2/A in an extent of 255 square yards, Ward No.13, New Ward No.32, Kummari Palem, Bapatla Mandal, by closing the northern side pathway, as illegal and arbitrary. I.A.No.3 of 2023 is filed seeking stay of construction of the Temple and drainage canal on the northern side of the petitioner's house. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Abhishek, learned counsel, representing Sri M. Manohar Reddy, learned standing counsel for respondent No.2. Learned counsel for respondent No.2, on instructions dated 06.12.2023 furnished by the Commissioner, Bapatla Municipality, submits that an old tree and Temple were removed in the process of NH-214A road work and Kummaripalem Temple Committee has taken up construction of a small Temple on the extreme South side edge of the road, without obtaining permission. Therefore, Municipality issued notices to stop construction.	

		In the above facts and circumstances of the case, learned counsel for the petitioner shall take steps to implead Kummaripalem Temple Committee as party respondent to the writ petition. Post on 18.12.2023. In the mean time, Commissioner, Bapatla Municipality shall take immediate steps, in accordance with law and see that no further construction is made. SRS, J lkn	
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
