Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus to declare the action of respondent Nos. 2 and 3 in not providing security by arranging 2+2 gunmen to the petitioner for his protection even inspite of existence of the life threat to the petitioner as arbitrary, illegal and violation of the Article 22 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to arrange necessary security to the petitioner by providing 2+2 gunmen forthwith in the interest of justice;
