Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue Order or Direction or Writ one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the impugned proceedings Rc.No.4955/AA/2023 dt.17-7-2023 and also proceedings in Rc.No.4955/AA/2023 dt. 1-8-2023 of the 5th Respondent in terminating the services of the petitioners w.e.f. 16-8-2023 as arbitrary, illegal, unlawful, non-application of mind, discriminatory, violative of principles of natural justice and Art.14 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently by setting aside the same, direct the Respondents to continue the services of the petitioners as Rogimitra in the 5th Respondent Hospital as earlier with all consequential and attendant benefits.

Petition under Section 151 of CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the impugned proceedings Rc.No.4955/AA/2023 dt.17-7-2023 and also proceedings in Rc.No.4955/AA/2023 dt. 1-8-2023 of the 5th Respondent while directing the Respondents to continue the services of the petitioners as Rogimitra in the 5th Respondent Hospital as earlier pending disposal of WP 20096 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.
