Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of a writ of mandamus declaring the action of the 1st respondent in issuing G.O. Rt No. 679 Revenue (Excise) Department dated 31-07-2023 wherein formulating the guidelines for allocation of personnel between Special Enforcement Bureau and Prohibition and Excise Department and vice versa and consequential GO Rt No. 685 Revenue (Excise) Department dated 31-07-2023 issued by the 1st respondent wherein allotted the petitioners to Special Enforcement Bureau is illegal, arbitrary, unjust and violation of Article 14 and 16 of the constitution of India and consequently set aside the same by directing the respondents to permit the petitioners to continue in Prohibition and Excise Department;

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the operation of G.O. Rt No. 679 Revenue (Excise) Department dated 31-07-2023 and consequential of G.O. Rt No. 685 Revenue (Excise) Department dated 31-07-2023 of the 1st respondent in so far as the petitioners are concerned and continue them in Prohibition and Excise Department, pending disposal of WP 20128 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.
