Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that, previously the 2nd respondent-Special Deputy Collector, after conducting enquiry, has dropped the proceedings in respect of the subject property vide its order dated 29.12.1980 in L.T.R.P.No.208/78. He further submitted that, now the very same Special Deputy Collector once again issued notice vide L.T.R.P.No.34/2023 for the very same scheduled property which is nothing but re-enquiring the matter again and again without having jurisdiction and also barred by res-judicata. As such, the petitioner need not appear and invite any order in the said proceedings. Accordingly, prayed to pass appropriate orders in that regard.	

		Perused the record. The proceedings L.T.R.P.No.208/78 shows that the petition against the subject property has been dropped and now, for the very same property the present notice vide L.T.R.P.No.34/2023 has been issued which is impugned the present writ petition. Prima facie, there is a point made out for consideration. There is some force in the contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that, the authorities cannot be permitted to re-enquire again and again and the same is barred by the principles of res-judicata, as such this court is inclined to pass following order: There shall be stay of all further proceedings in LTRP.No.34/2023 on the file 2nd respondent, until further orders.
