Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ of Mandamus, or other appropriate writ, order or direction, to declare the inaction of the respondents especially the respondents No.2 to 5 in considering my application dated 10.12.2021 for grant of permission, for retail sale of Bio-Diesel by starting retail outlet at Sy.No.47-A1B, 47-A3 of Kesanupalli (V), Dachepalli (M), Palnadu District, Andhra Pradesh by me under the name and style of Sri Sai Tirumala Traders, though more than one year is elapsed is illegal, arbitrary, unjust and violative of Articles 14,19, and 21 of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to grant permission for establishing Bio-Fuel Retail outlet for selling Bio-Diesel B100 by duly considering my application.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents 4 and 5 to conclude the enquiry and make specific recommendation in accordance with the guidelines as ordered by the District Collector by his proceedings in File No.REV GNT-CSECOPAR (NOC)/52/2021-SA (C6)-COLGNT immediately, pending disposal of WP 2292 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

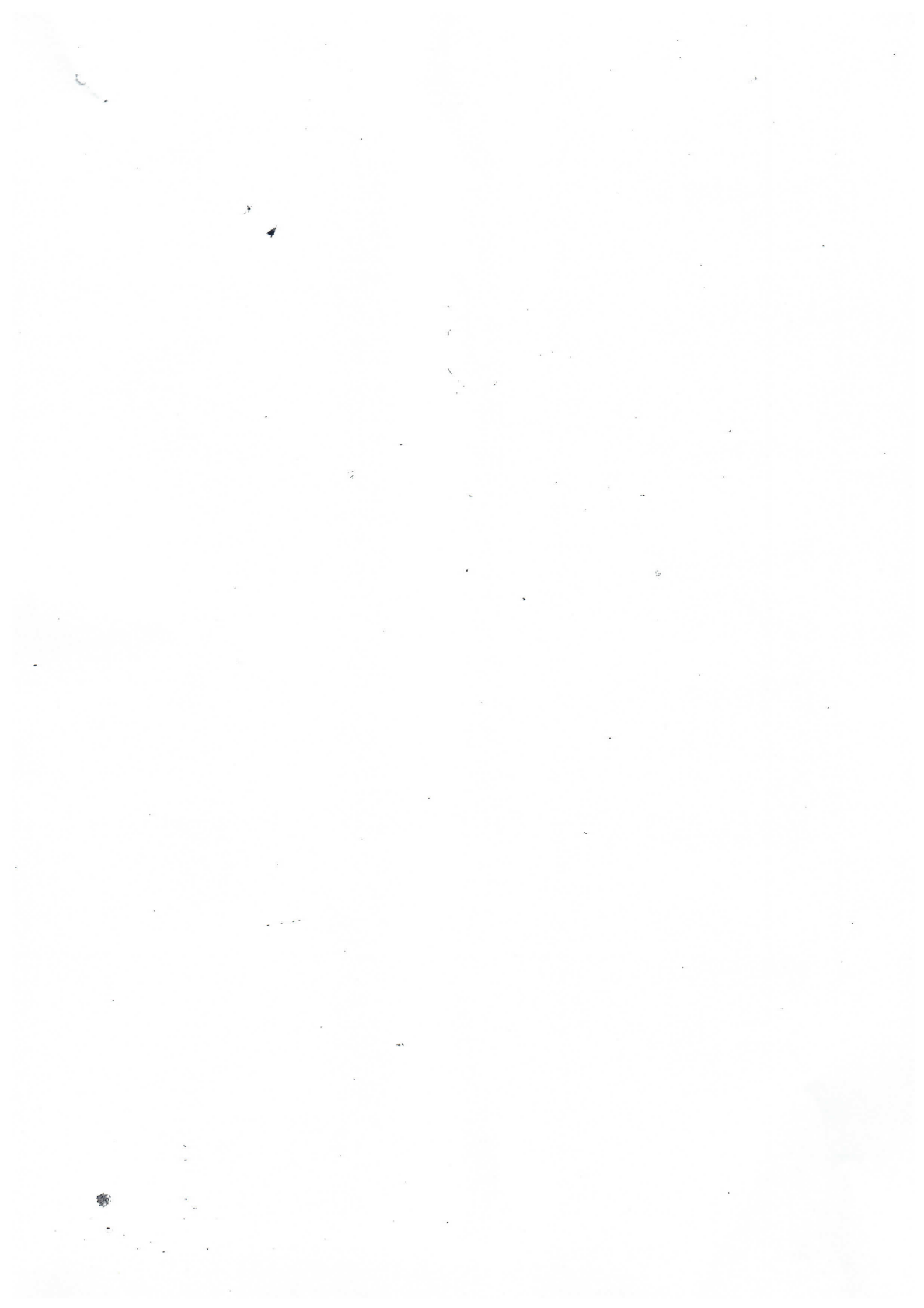
