Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the action of the respondent without considering the representation of the petitioner dt 20.01.2023 and taking steps for changing the name of the street of 'Tula Vari Street' -in Bandarulanka Village of Dr.B.R. Ambedkar Konaseema District without following the procedure laid down in Panchyat Raj Act which is illegal improper and arbitrary and violation of Principles of natural justice and consequentially direct the respondents without considering the representation of the Petitioners dt.20.01.2023 not to take any steps for changing the name of 'Tula Vari Street' in bandarulanka Village of Dr. Br. Ambedkar Konaseema District.

Petition under Section 151 of CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents with out considering the representation made by the petitioners dt.20.01.2023 not to take steps for changing the name of "Tula Vari Street" in Bandarulanka Village of Dr.Br.Ambedkar Konaseema District Pending disposal of the Writ Petition No. 2831 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

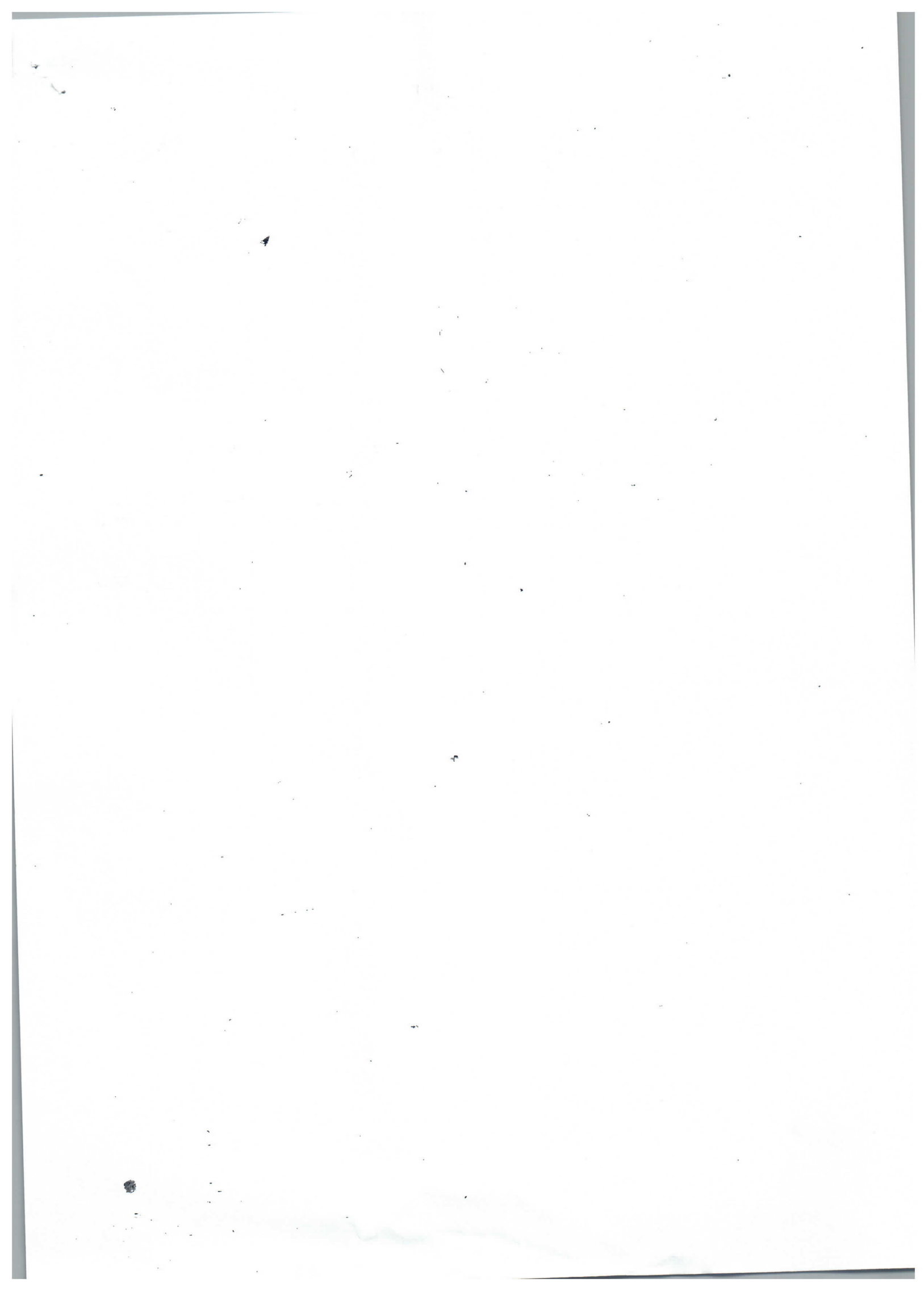
