Sri S.Rajeswara Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for Ware Housing Corporation takes notice for respondent Nos. 3 and 4. Learned counsel for the respondents seeks time for filing counter. List the matter after four weeks. <u>I.A.No.1 of 2023</u> Heard both sides. In similar circumstances, this Court passed an order in W.P.No.33613 of 2022, dated 14.10.2022, the operative portion of the said order reads as follows: <i>“There shall be an interim suspension of the impugned Cir. Memo.1813129/FIN01-HR/212/2022-HR-IV, dated 23.09.2022 issued by the Government and the proceedings in SWC/E1/403/2022-6, SWC/E1/403/2022-5, SWC/E1/403/2022-1, SWC/E1/403/2022-7, SWC/E1/403/2022-2, SWC/E1/403/2022-3, SWC/E1/403/2022-8, dt 01.10.22 respectively to accord permission to relieve on 31.07.2022,</i>	

31.07.2022, 28.02.2022, 31.08.2022, 31.03.2022, 31.05.2022, 31.08.2022 issued by the 4th respondent.

Further, the respondents are directed to continue the petitioners till the age of superannuation of 62 years.”

Hence, in view of the aforesaid order, this Court is inclined to pass the same order in this case also.

Therefore, there shall be an interim suspension of the Circular Memo (especially para 6) No. 1813129/FIN01-HR/212/2022-HR-IV, dated 23.09.2022 and consequential proceedings issued by the 4th respondent in Memo No.SWC/E2/4798/2022-01, dt.26.12.2022. Further, the respondents are hereby directed to continue the petitioner in service till he attains the age of superannuation of 62 years.
