WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate Sri. P HEMACHANDRA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly a Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 2nd respondent in issuing proceedings No.4198318/D13-1/2021, dt.12.03.2022 insisting for submission of NOC before the 4th respondent for grant of quarry lease to the petitioner in an extent or 1,000 Hectors in Sy.No.140/9, 368/1, 5 & 6 of Nisankadurgam (Group), Surendranagaram Village, Karvetinagaram Mandal of Chittoor District is Illegal, arbitrary contrary to the mandate of Rule 35 of AP MMC Rules, 1966, apart from being violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the 2nd respondent not to insist for submission of NOC for grant of quarry lease to the petitioner for Gravel, Road metal and building stone,

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P HEMACHANDRA Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR MINES AND GEOLOGY for the Respondents, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

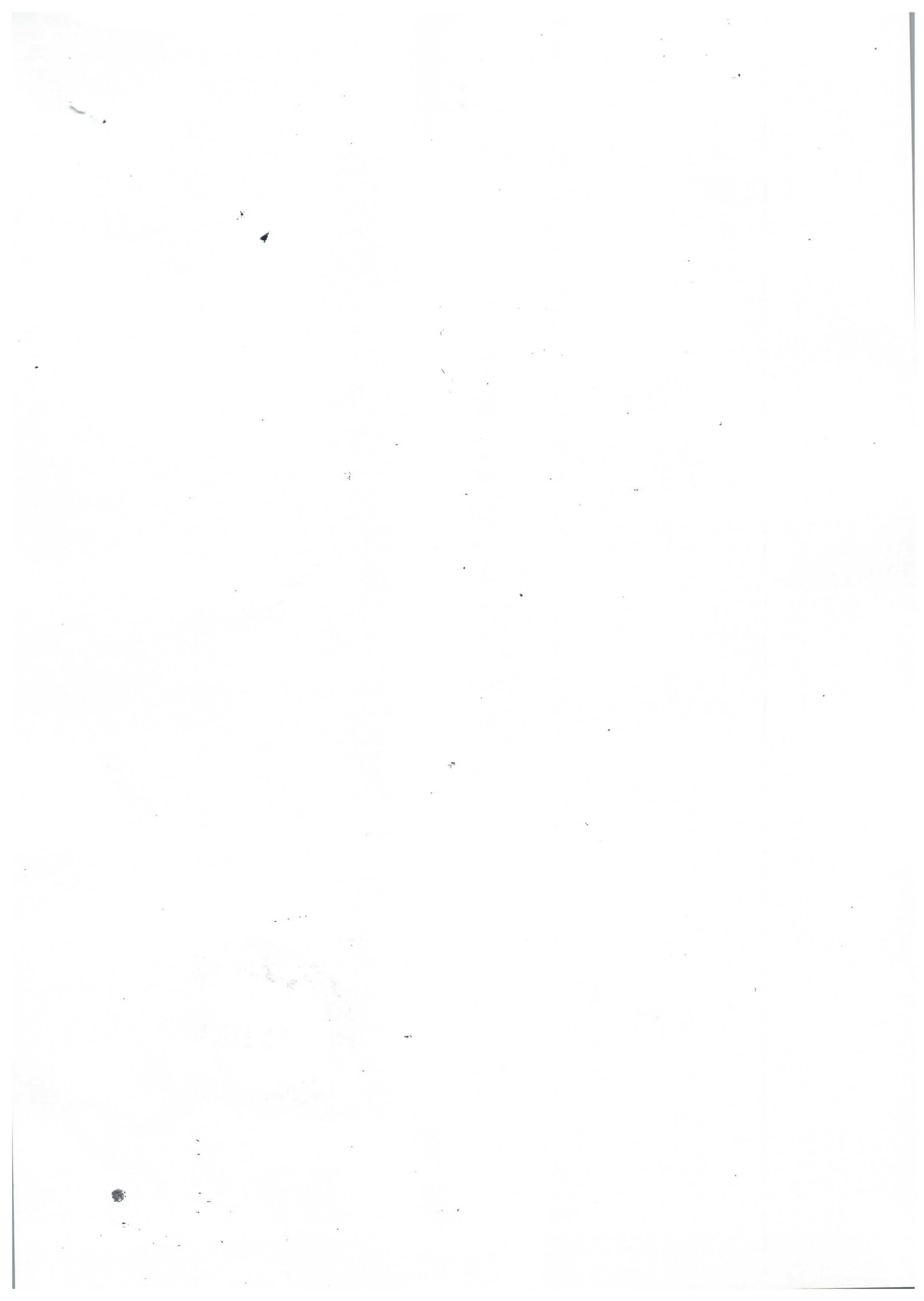
