ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue for the respondent Nos.1 to 4.

2. The grievance of the Writ Petitioner is that their representation, dated 03.02.2023 addressed to the 2nd respondent and the representation, dated 28.10.2022 have not been considered so far. Hence, this Writ Petition.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, the petitioner's lands were acquired by the Government for the

purpose of Kakinada Special Economic Zone at Kodada and Srungavruksham Village of Tondangi Mandal. Thus, they became as land looser and no compensation was paid so far. Hence they made representation to the 3rd respondent on 28.10.2022. Since, it was not acted upon, the petitioner gave another representation to the 2nd respondent, dated 03.02.2023 and it is also not considered so far.

4. On the other hand, the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for the respondent Nos.1 to 4 submits that their representation of the petitioner, dated 03.02.2023 addressed to the 2nd respondent would be considered by following the due procedure.

5. In view of the above said facts and circumstances, the 2nd respondent is directed to consider and dispose of the petitioner's representation, dated 03.02.2023 strictly in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible by conducting necessary enquiry and hearing of all the parties concerned.

Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.

As a sequel, Miscellaneous Petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
