02	09.02.2023	<u>NV, J</u> Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader for Higher Education. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the impugned proceedings dated 02.12.2022 was issued cancelling the correspondentship of the respondent college which resulted in threatening the petitioner to handover the charges to some other person. It is further submitted that in the impugned proceedings it is stated that the petitioner is harassing the staff and retired employees of the respondent institution and not forwarding their salary and pension proposals to the higher authorities. On the other hand, learned Government Pleader for Higher Education submits that the correspondent of the institution is not acting as per the requirement of bylaws of the society as well as for the welfare of the staff and retired employees. Therefore, special officer has been appointed to lookafter the day to day administration of the college, more particularly, in the place of correspondent but not in the place of principal. He further submits that the impugned proceedings are no way concerned with the principal. Moreover, if	

		any action to be initiated against the principal, it should be initiated only by following due process of law and after issuing notices in accordance with law. In view of same, this Court cannot be interfered in the present impugned proceedings dated 02.12.2022 since the petitioner has no locus in respect of the impugned proceedings which is against the correspondentship but not against the petitioner. Therefore, learned Government Pleader is granted time to filing counter. List the matter on 03.03.2023. NV, J BSP	
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
