Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ or Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 3rd respondent in interfering with the possession of the House property of the petitioner in Sy.No.143/1 in Door No.30-24 of Payakaraopeta Village and Mandal, Anakapalli District, Andhra Pradesh in an extent of 100 square yards under due influence of respondents 4 and 5 herein and also the action of the 6th respondent in calling the petitioner to the police station as illegal, arbitrary and also oppose to Article 300-A of the Constitution of India as well as oppose to all cannons of justice consequentially direct the respondents 3 and 6 herein not to interfere with the property of the petitioner in Sy.No.143/1 in Door No.30-24 of Payakaraopeta Village and Mandal, Anakapalli District, Andhra Pradesh in an extent of 100 square yards as well as with the personal life and liberty without there being any cause .

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents 3 and 6 herein not to interfere with the property of the petitioner in Sy. No. 143/1 in Door No. 30-24 of Payakaraopeta Village and Mandal, Anakapalli District, Andhra Pradesh in an extent of 100 square yards as well as with the personal life and liberty without there being any cause, pending disposal of WP 4174 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 3rd Respondent to reconstruct the Petitioner's shed (dwelling house) in petitioner's land in extent of 100 Sq.Yds in Sy.No.143/1 in Door No.30-24 Payakaraopeta Village and Mandal, Anakapalli District, pending disposal of WP 4174 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 6th Respondent/police to protect the petitioner and her family members and house property without interfering by/from the Respondents 3 to 5 into petitioner's land in extent of 100 Sq.Yds in Sy.No.143/1 in Door No.30-24 Payakaraopeta Village and Mandal, Anakapalli District, pending disposal of WP 4174 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.
