WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate Sri N PREMRAJ presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue appropriate writ or order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the action of the 3rd respondent in converting the land in Sy.No. 455 -2 an extent of Ac.1.00 cents and Sy.No.467-2 an extent of Ac.2.00 cents from agricultural land to non-agricultural purpose which is subject land of Maruva vanka in Anantapur Town and District vide D.Dis.D2/1405/2019, dt Nil-9-2019 of the 3rd respondent is illegal, arbitrary and in violation of Principles of Natural justice and in violation of Art.14, 21, 48-A and 51-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to remove the ongoing construction of the 5th respondent in Sy.No. 455 -2 an extent of Ac.1.00 cents and Sy.No.467-2 an extent of Ac.2.00 cents of Maruva vanka in Anantapur Town and District in the interest of justice .

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri N PREMRAJ Advocate for the Petitioner and of , GP FOR REVENUE for Respondent Nos. 1 to 4, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.5 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
