Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 3rd respondent in transferring the petitioner vide proceeding in A.P.S.R.T.C. No.P1/255/11/2023-MDP dated. 16.02.2023 from Maddalapalem depot to Paderu depot is illegal, arbitrary without competency and jurisdiction, in the middle of academic year basing on corn complaints violative of principles of natural justice and contrary to the Andhra Pradesh Transport Operations Sub-Ordinate Services Rules, 2021, issued vide G.O.Ms.No. 21, Transport, Roads and Buildings (TR.B) Department, dt. 24.05.2021 and also violation of Articles 14 and 21 of the constitution of India and sei aside the same and consequently direct the respondents to continue the petitioner as conductor in Maddilapalem depot,

Petition under Section 151 of CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the WRIT petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the orders of transfer issued by the 3rd respondent vide proceedings in A.P.S.R.T.C.
