Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ or Writs, Order or Direction, declaring the action of the Respondents for non-compliance of (1) FTR No.4121920300733 dated 09.09.2020 for Rs. 4293/- (2) FTR No.4121920300735 dated 09.09.2020 for Rs. 2287/- (3) FTR No. 4121920300737 dated 09.09.2020 for Rs.1687/- (4) FTR No.4121920300739 dated 09.09.2020 for Rs. 45433/- total for an amount of Rs. 53700/- for the material supplied by the petitioner as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Arts. 14, 19(1)(g) and 21 of Constitution of India and against the provisions of rules and regulations of National Rural Employment Guarantee Act and consequently direct the Respondents to forthwith comply with the above Funds Transfer Orders (1410s) and pay interest on the due amounts from the date of completion of contract to till the date of payment @ 24 percent p.a..
