Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ or direction or order more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of respondents no's 1 to 5 in not taking any action against the respondent 6, who are taking steps to demolish the Lord Ganesha Mandir and encroaching the public site, which vests with the respondent No.5, to an extent of 300 Sq.yds in RS Numbers 416/1B.1C,ID,413/1A,1B,1C,2A1 and A2 of Konthamuru Village, Kolan-wru Gram-Panchayat, Rajamahendravaram Rural Mandal, East Godavari District, as illegal, arbitrary and contrary to the provisions of A.P.Panchayat Raj Act and Rules made thereunder and violation of Article 21 of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to act upon the representation made by the petitioner dt. 31-01-2023, and pass

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Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to consider the representation dt. 31-01-2023, made by petitioner, pending disposal of the writ petition and pass
