Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus, or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, declaring the action of the 1st respondent in issuing Memo No.1693243/1/2023-SW-EDU-Part(1), dated 24.2.2023 adjustment of outsourcing staff engaged to the Services of Cooking, Housekeeping and Sanitation by the petitioner against the sanctioned posts of merged/converted Pre-Metric Hostels in the 7 Districts AP Corporation for Outsourced Services (APCOS), without issuing any notice though there is an agreement between the petitioner and the 3rd respondent as illegal, arbitrary and violation of Articles 14, 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently set aside the Memo No.1693243/1/2023-SW-EDU-Part(1), dated 24.2.2023 in relation to the Krishna District in SI.No.5.
