

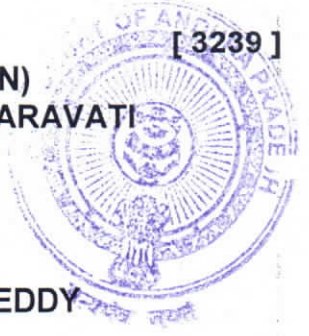

WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI P NARASIMHULU presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased issue any writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the respondents no. 5 in not receiving the SSC Examination fee from the petitioner as illegal, arbitrary and violation of Article 14, 21 of the Constitution of India and contrary to the Andhra Pradesh SSC Examination Fee, 2023 issued by the 2nd respondent to consequently direct the 5th respondent to receive the examination fee from the petitioner

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P NARASIMHULU Advocate for the Petitioner, and of GP FOR SCHOOL EDUCATION for Respondent Nos.1 to 4 directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
