ORDER:

The present Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following relief:

“...to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the respondents in trying to demarcate my landed schedule property and insisting me to vacate from my landed property in an extent of Ac.2.00 Cents in Sy.No.309-4 which is bounded by East: Chejerla Venkataiah, S/o Ramanaiah Sy.No.309 (High tension Pole), West: Chejarla Ramanaiah, S/o Rosaiah, Sy.No.310, North: (Kunta), Nallipogu Rosaiah, S/o Seshaiah, Sy.No.308, South: Vaddipalli Pencalaiah, S/o Chinna Penchalaiah @ Varapu Karraiah of Naginenigunta Revenue Village, Marripadu Mandal of S.P.S.R. Nellore District, without following any known procedure established by law, as illegal, irregular, irrational, without jurisdiction and violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents not to dispossess my landed property and not to demarcate my landed property and not to interfere in any manner with my peaceful possession and enjoyment over my said landed schedule properties and pass such other order or orders...”

2. Heard Sri Dhanunjaya Baru, learned counsel for petitioner and learned Government Pleader for respondents.

3. The writ petition is filed challenging the action of the respondents in trying to demarcate the petitioner's land and insisting the petitioner to vacate from the land in an extent of Ac.2.00 Cents in Sy.No.309-4 which is bounded by East: Chejerla Venkataiah, S/o Ramanaiah Sy.No.309 (High tension Pole), West: Chejarla Ramanaiah, S/o Rosaiah, Sy.No.310, North:(Kunta), Nallipogu Rosaiah, S/o Seshaiah, Sy.No.308, South: Vaddipalli Pencalaiah, S/o Chinna

Penchalaiah Varapu Karraiah of Naginenigunta Revenue Village, Marripadu Mandal of S.P.S.R. Nellore District.

4. Respondent No.4 filed counter-affidavit and stated that the respondents are not trying to dispossess the petitioner and not insisting the petitioner to vacate from the land in an extent of Ac.2.00 cents in Sy.No.309-4 of Naginenigunta Village, Marripadu Mandal of S.P.S.R. Nellore District.

5. In view of the counter-affidavit filed by respondent No.4, the present Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondents to follow due process of law, if at all they intend to conduct survey. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
