1.	18.04.2023	<u>BSB, J</u> Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the respondents No.5 to 7 highhandedly entered into the business premises of the petitioner and without issuing any notice demanded bribe and interfered with the smooth administration of the business. The petitioner has also filed petition seeking interim relief of revocation of suspension of GST registration certificate. Learned Government Pleader for Commercial Tax representing respondent No.4 submitted that the respondents No.5 to 7 are duly authorized to conduct search as per the proceedings referred in the notice dated 10.03.2023 and the ACB authorities are in no way concerned with official act done by R-5 to R-7. He further submitted that no prior notice is contemplated except where audit is done. He further submitted that the interim relief is sought is beyond the scope of the main writ petition and that no relief or ground is taken with regard to revocation of suspension of GST registration certificate.
