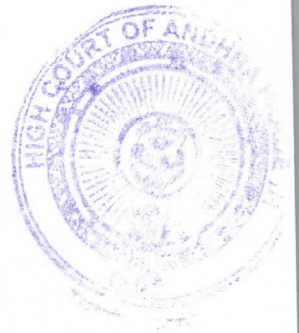

WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through its Advocate Smt. Popuri Lakshmi Priyanvita, presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, Order or Orders, Direction or Directions to declare the action of the 1st respondent dated 12.04.2023 in disapproving the application of the petitioner for establishment of new Dental College in the name of Dheera Institute of Dental Sciences and Hospital, Nellore, Andhra Pradesh on the ground that the land possessed by the petitioner was not taken on lease from Govt. or its authorities but was taken from private individual, though such a thing was not applied to the other existing Dental Colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh, as arbitrary, illegal and unsustainable and to set aside the same and to issue a consequential direction to the respondents to grant approval to the petitioner for the academic year 2023-24 to start a Dental College without insisting for possessing land taken on lease from Govt. or its Authorities;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Smt. Popuri Lakshmi Priyanvita, Advocate for the Petitioner, Sri. Jupudi V.K. Yagnadutt, Standing Counsel for respondent No.1 and Sri. B. Srinivasarao, Standing Counsel for respondent No.2, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
