1. Heard Mr. Salunke, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for respondent/State, some time.

2. Learned APP submits that the case is rest upon the circumstantial evidence. Firstly; the accused was lastly seen in the company of the deceased, secondly; the accused has pointed out the place from where the dead body of the deceased was recovered and thirdly; the accused pointed out the place from where the mobile of the deceased was recovered. Mr. Salunke, learned counsel for petitioner has disputed these facts.

3. Looking to the serious nature of the offence, at the first instance I am of the opinion that the report shall be called from the concerned Sessions Judge, as

to within how many days/months the court will be in position to dispose of the matter.

4. Stand over to 27.04.2018. Call the report from the concerned Sessions Judge. The Registry of this Court to see that the report should reach this Court within one week.
