1. No one appears for the applicant-original complainant. This application is filed seeking leave to file criminal appeal challenging the judgment and order dated 7th April 2016 passed by the learned 18th Joint Civil Judge Junior Division & Judicial Magistrate First Class, Pune in Summary Trial Criminal Case No.6712 of 2015, whereby the learned Magistrate has acquitted respondent no.1 for offence punishable under section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

2. The Application was filed in the year 2019 and has not been circulated even once by the applicant. It appears that the applicant has

lost interest in prosecuting the matter. The Court is not inclined to keep such matters pending indefinitely.
