The Court of J.M.F.C., Thane as per order 24th November 2017 was pleased to issue process against Accused Nos.1 to 5 for the offence under sections 403, 406, 420 r/w 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and the case was dismissed for the offence under sections 465, 467, 468, 471, 506 r/w 120-B, 34 of IPC. The complainant was desirous of challenging the said order. There was a delay of 244 days in preferring the Revision.
2. There are no effective orders passed in delay condonation application. Even first order of issuance of notice is not passed. Today, no one is present on behalf of the Applicant. Probably, the case before the trial Court might have also progressed.
