1. Mr.Naphade, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that by way of chamber summons no.222 of 2018 certain judicial orders and notifications as issued by the State Government are sought to be relied by the petitioner.
2. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, Mr.Naphade would agree that the judicial orders can be cited during the course of the arguments as also the notifications issued by the State Government also can be relied. As the

draft amendment already contained notifications, the same can be treated as compilation of these documents.

3. Learned AGP does not dispute the position as urged by Mr.Naphade as the petition is of the year 2010 and it cannot be in the interest of the parties to adjourn the matter only for the reason that the petitioner relied on certain notifications which are already in vogue and the judicial orders.

4. Chamber summons is accordingly disposed of by treating the orders as annexed to the chamber summons and the notifications to form part of a compilation which the petitioner would submit.

5. Learned Counsel for the petitioner is permitted to keep ready a separate compilation of these orders and notifications and serve the same on the respondents.
