1. On 1 February 2019 this Court had disposed of the above chamber
summons by permitting the petitioner to place on record a compilation of

relevant orders and the notifications. The petition was accordingly taken up for hearing. However, during the course of the argument of the petitioner, it transpires that the petitioner would intend to urge grounds which are based on the proposed amendment as set out in the schedule as annexed to the chamber summons, as also the petitioner intends to raise one more additional ground.

2. After hearing the learned Counsel for the parties, it would be appropriate and in the interest of justice and for effective adjudication of this petition, the petitioner is permitted to amend the petition in terms of the schedule annexed to the chamber summons as also permitted to add one additional ground. Needless to observe that it is open for the respondents to urge their respective pleas, and allowing of the chamber summons is without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the respondents.

3. The order dated 1 February 2019 is accordingly modified to the above extent. Necessary amendment be carried out within a period of one week from today.

4. Amended copy of the petition be served on the respondents within one week from today. Respondents if so desire are permitted to file reply affidavit to the amended petition within two weeks from service of the amended petition.
5. Reply affidavit be served on the petitioner well in advance.
6. Needless to observe that the intervener would also be heard on all these issues including the amended petition.
7. Stand over to 22 March 2019.
