After hearing learned counsels for both the parties, Mr. Dubey, learned counsel for petitioners submits that the impugned order dated 9 April 2018 is an appealable order under Section 247 of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code, 1966 and, therefore seeks liberty to withdraw the present petition and file an appeal under Section 247 of the Act.

2. Liberty as prayed for is granted. Appeal to be filed within a period of 8 weeks from today. If the petitioner files an appeal, then the Appellate Authority is directed to dispose

of the same on merits within a period of 12 weeks thereafter and after complying with the principles of natural justice and after hearing the parties.
