2] The contemnor Mrs. Mangalabi w/o Digambar Meshram shall remain personally present on 17.12.2018.

3] Mrs. Mangalabai Meshram shall file an affidavit detailing movable and immovable properties owned by her or by any firm or company or concern in which she may have share and interest.

4] The contempt alleged is that notwithstanding the order dated 01.11.2007, respondent 16 has alienated the suit property.

5] The contemnor does not file an affidavit on the lines indicated above and further clearly stating that there is no alienation or other breach of the order of this court, charge shall be framed on the next date of hearing.

6] The contemnor is put on notice that if the charge

is framed on the next date of hearing she shall be heard on the charge and the contempt petition may be disposed of on the same day.
