2. We find that the matters can be disposed of by adopting order dated 01.10.2018 in Writ Petition No. 3772 of 2018 and other connected matters.

3. Accordingly, if any vacancies are now available and the petitioners are willing to join at those places, the decision will have to be taken by the employer first.

4. We, therefore, direct the petitioners to make a representation pointing out vacancies at relevant places within a period of one week from today, if such representation is already not made. We direct the respondent – Chief Executive Officer to take a decision on such representation within a period of three weeks from the date of communication of this order to it.

4. With these directions, we dispose of the writ petitions. No order as to costs.
