Heard learned Counsel for the parties.

The Petitioner has challenged the notices issued by the District Magistrate dated 12 September 2018 and 18 February 2019 suspending the No Objection Certificate granted in favour of the Petitioner who was running a Petrol Pump at village Navkhala Tah. Nagbhid. While the Petition was pending, the final order has been passed on the show cause notice by the Collector on 27 September 2019 and No Objection Certificate granted to the Petitioner is cancelled.

3. The learned Counsel for the Respondents points out that as against this order an appeal is provided under Rule 154 of the Petroleum Rules, 2002. The learned Counsel for the Petitioner does not dispute this position but states that to enable the Petitioner to approach the Appellate Authority time may be granted and the ad-interim order operating in this Petition be continued for some time.

4. The learned Counsel for Respondent No.5 has no objection.

5. Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, we dispose of this Petition in view of the alternate remedy available to the Petitioner keeping all contentions of the parties open and directing that the ad-interim order granted in this Petition shall continue for a period of 8 weeks from today.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of.
