1. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that by way of
an order dated 16.06.2021, the Director, Post Graduate



Institute of Medical Education and Research, Chandigarh, being the disciplinary authority, had imposed a penalty of compulsory retirement upon the applicant with immediate effect. Aggrieved by the said order, the applicant has preferred an appeal before Respondent No. 2 on 15.07.2021.

2. Grievance of the applicant herein is that a period of more than two months has elapsed, but upto today, the appellate authority has not decided the applicant's appeal dated 15.07.2021.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the applicant will be satisfied if the present Original Application is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide his pending appeal dated 15.07.2021 within a time frame.
4. Keeping in view the aforesaid limited prayer made by learned counsel for the applicant, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the present Original Application at the admission stage itself without entering into the merits of the case.
5. Accordingly, the Original Application is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the applicant's



pending appeal dated 15.07.2021 and pass a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law. Before taking such a decision, the applicant shall also be afforded an opportunity of hearing. The whole exercise shall be undertaken within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

6. Ordered accordingly. However, there shall be no orders so as to costs.
