ORAL ORDER

{ Per Hon'ble Mrs. Minnie Mathew, Member (Admn.) }

Heard Mr. E. Krishna Swamy, learned counsel for the applicant and Mr. A. Vijaya Bhaskar Babu representing Mrs. B. Gayatri Varma, learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents.

2. The applicant has sought the following reliefs:

“8.1 Declare that the applicant is eligible for dearness relief, interim relief, etc. from 01.7.1994 to 5.7.1999, as they existed on his notional pension at Rs.1007/- till his 1/3rd commuted pension was restored.

8.2 Direct the respondents to arrange payment of Rs.1,08,541/- within 30 days from the date of receipt of a copy of the order of this Hon'ble Tribunal, failing which interest at 12% p.a. for any delayed payment;

8.3 Award reasonable costs; and

8.4 Pass any such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Tribunal deems it fit and proper, in the circumstances of the case and in the interest of justice.”

3. On perusal of the material on record, it is seen that the applicant has submitted Annexure A-II representation dated 05.12.2016 to the 1st & 2nd Respondents. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has not received any reply thereon and that similar matters have already been decided by this Tribunal in OAs No.204/2012 & batch dated 18.11.2014 & OA No.1333/2012 dated 27.1.2015.

4. In view of the fact that the representation of the applicant is still reported to be pending before the respondents, the O.A is disposed of at



admission stage with a direction to the 1st Respondent to consider the representation already submitted and also treat this O.A. as a representation and consider the issues raised by the applicant in the light of the judicial pronouncements cited by him. The respondents shall pass reasoned and speaking orders thereon and communicate the same to the applicant within two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. It is made clear that at this stage the Tribunal has not entered into the merits of the case. No order as to costs.

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
