ORDER

The present Original Application has been filed by the applicant under Section 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 making therein a prayer for issuance of a direction to respondents to issue his marks sheet with respect to the result declared pursuant to

notification No. 05-S (PSC) of 2023 dated 02.02.2023 pertaining to the Secretariat Assistant Training Course Departmental Examination.



2. At the very outset, Mr. Vikram Rathore, learned counsel for the applicant submitted that before filing the present Original Application, the applicant had submitted a representation on 20.02.2023 before the Additional Secretary to Government, General Administration Department, Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir, which has not been decided upto now.

3. Learned counsel further submitted that the applicant will be satisfied, if the present Original Application is disposed of with a direction to respondents to decide his pending representation within a time frame.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the applicant, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the Original Application at the admission stage itself without entering into the merits of the case.

5. Accordingly, the Original Application is disposed of with a direction to the Secretary to Government, General Administration Department, Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir to decide the applicant's pending representation dated 20.02.2023 and pass a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law. Before taking

such a decision, the applicant shall also be afforded an opportunity of hearing. The whole exercise shall be undertaken within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.



6. Ordered accordingly.

7. However, there shall be no orders so as to costs.
