**O R D E R(Oral)****Per: SURESH KUMAR MONGA, MEMBER (J):**

1. Aggrieved by an order of dismissal from service, issued by the Competent Authority on 09.06.2020, the applicant herein preferred an appeal before the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Union Territory, Chandigarh, which was dismissed on 14.01.2021. Still aggrieved, the applicant preferred a second appeal before the Director General of Police, Union Territory, Chandigarh on 01.02.2021.
2. Grievance of the applicant herein is that a period of about six months has elapsed but upto today the Director General of Police, Union Territory, Chandigarh has not decided his pending appeal.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the applicant will be satisfied if the present Original Application is disposed of with a direction to the Director General of Police, Union Territory, Chandigarh to decide his pending appeal dated 01.02.2021 and to pass a reasoned and speaking order over the same within a time-frame.
4. Keeping in view the afore-stated limited prayer made by learned counsel for the applicant, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the present original application, at the admission stage itself, without entering into the merit of the case.



5. Accordingly, the original application is disposed of with a direction to the Director General of Police, Union Territory, Chandigarh (Respondent No. 2 herein), to decide the applicant's pending appeal dated 01.02.2021 and pass a reasoned and speaking order thereon, in accordance with law. Before taking such a decision, the applicant shall also be afforded an opportunity of hearing. The whole exercise shall be undertaken within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

6. Ordered accordingly. However, there shall be no orders so as to costs.
