Per: SURESH KUMAR MONGA, MEMBER (J):

1. The present Original Application has been filed by the applicant under Section 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 making therein the following prayer:-

“(i) To direct the respondents to promote the applicant from the date his juniors were promoted to the post of technician grade I i.e. from 30.08.2018.

(ii) Further, to grant the consequential benefits of arrears alongwith interest @12% p.a.”

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the applicant stated that before filing the present original application, the applicant had submitted a representation dated 09.02.2022 (Annexure A-5), which was followed by a legal notice dated 20.05.2022 (Annexure A-6).

3. Grievance of the applicant herein is that neither his representation has been decided, nor any reply to aforesaid notice has been given by the respondents uptil now.

4. Learned counsel stated that the applicant will be satisfied



if the present original application is disposed of with a direction to respondents to decide his aforesaid representation within a time frame.

5. Keeping in view the aforestated limited prayer made by learned counsel for the applicant, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the present Original Application, at the admission stage itself, without entering into the merits of the case.

6. Accordingly, the Original Application is disposed of with a direction to the Transport Secretary, Chandigarh Administration, Chandigarh, to decide the applicant's representation dated 09.02.2022 (Annexure A-5) and pass a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law. Before taking such a decision, the applicant shall also be afforded an opportunity of hearing. The whole exercise shall be undertaken within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

7. Ordered accordingly. However, there shall be no orders so as to costs.
