**ORAL ORDER**

PER HON'BLE Mr. ASHISH KALIA, MEMBER (J)

This Original Application was filed under section 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 praying for the following relief(s):

“To call for records pertaining to wrong fixation of pay of the applicant and denial of bunching benefit to the applicant and declare that the action/inaction of the respondents is illegal, arbitrary and against Rules and in violation of Articles 14 and 21 of Constitution of India and

(i) declare that the applicant is eligible for the bunching benefit as per Rule 7 (1) of CCS (Revised Pension) Rules, 2008, Notes there-under and illustrations 4A & 4B (Annexure-III) and OM No.F No.1/1/2008-IC dated 30.08.2008 (Annexure II);

(ii) direct the respondents to refix the pay of the applicant by granting bunching benefit on par with others as per Rules and Orders of various Benches of CAT; and

(iii) further direct the respondents to revise the pension and pensionary benefits as per the revised pay and pay arrears with interest thereon at the rate of 12%.”

2. Heard both counsel.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant has appraised this Tribunal that a favourable order was passed by Jaipur Bench of this Tribunal in ***OA 141/2012 SC Sharma Vs. Union of India & others.*** In view of this, applicant also is entitled to similar relief.





4. Applicant made representation on 1.10.2019 addressed to Respondent No.2. We hereby direct Respondent No.2 to dispose of the said representation within a period of 90 days from the date of receipt of this order.
5. OA is accordingly disposed of at the admission stage.
6. There shall be no order as to costs.
