Order of The Tribunal

While issuing notices on 17.02.2022, the matter was ordered to be listed on 28.02.2022 with a direction to respondents to file their written statement a day prior to the date fixed with an advance copy to learned counsel for the applicant. The respondents, however, could not file their written statement within the said stipulated period.

On 28.02.2022, Sh. Sanjay Goyal, learned Senior Central Government Standing Counsel had prayed for and was allowed a weeks' more time to file the written statement and the matter was posted to 11.03.2022 i.e. today.

The respondents have still failed to file their written statement.

Today, Sh. Goyal, learned Senior Central Government Standing Counsel has stated that he has received a communication dated 10.03.2022 from the Accounts Officer (Legal), Haryana Telecom Circle, stating therein that eight weeks' time may be granted to respondents No. 1 and 2 to file their written statement.

A prayer has, thus, been made to grant eight weeks' more time to file the written statement.

Sh. Ajay Chauhan, learned counsel for the applicant is, however, pressing very hard to grant the interim relief by way of staying further inquiry proceedings.

In the interest of justice, a weeks' more time is granted to respondents to file their written statement.

It is made clear that if no written statement is filed by the respondents on or before the date fixed, the records in original shall be produced by respondent No. 2 enabling this Tribunal to adjudicate upon the matter.
