<u>Notes of The Registry</u>	<u>Order of The Tribunal</u>
	<u>MA/905/2025 (for extension of time)</u> This is an application filed by the respondents in the Original Application seeking extension of time to comply with our direction. According to the learned SPC appearing for the miscellaneous applicant, the Review Committee met and considered the case of the applicant. It had recommended continuation of suspension for a further period of 6 months from 18.05.2025 to 13.11.2025 by Anneuxure MA R-4. The learned Counsel sought extension of time for four months from 23.09.2025 to complete the entire process. The learned SPC attributed the delay of the respondents in the MA on the premise that she seeks documents one after another in the course of proceedings which delayed the proceedings. This is objected to by the learned Counsel for the respondents in the MA. After hearing the learned Counsel on both sides, we are inclined to direct the MA respondents to submit to the inquiry officer the list of all the relevant documents which she requires, within a period of 10 days from today. If such list is filed, the respondents shall either produce the documents if it is available and is relevant for the consideration of the inquiry and if not in their possession, to file a statement in that regard, within two weeks thereafter. The inquiry shall thereafter proceed and be completed within two months thereafter. Both sides shall co-operate. The CP stands adjourned. Post on 18.12.2025 for reporting the progress in the inquiry.
