	<u>Through Video Conferencing:</u> Heard SriM. Venkanna, learned counsel for the applicant. 2. ADMIT. SriA. RadhaKrishna, learned Senior Panel Counsel takes notice for the respondents and seeks four weeks time for filing reply. 3. The applicant has joined the respondent's organization as Junior Engineer (JE) (Elect) on 22.12.1983. He retired from service on 31.01.2019. He was issued Rule14 charge sheet on 22/23.03.2018 for unauthorized absence. The contention of the applicant is that he suffered from severe lungs problem and hence, could not attend office. After the retirement of the applicant, the respondents have not paid the retiral benefits and provisional pension to the applicant. Rule 69 of CCS (Pension) Rules 1972 lays down that provisional pension has to be granted even if there is a disciplinary case pending. 4. In view of the above said rule position, the respondents are directed to pay provisional pension to the applicant within 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of this interim order and also to pay the arrears, if any, on account of provisional pension. 5.
