Order of The Tribunal

Counsels for the parties are present.

This is remanded matter from Hon'ble High Court. The applicants are seeking regularisation which is opposed by the other side. Earlier, this Tribunal has rejected the OA by observing the following:

"9. Accordingly, we dispose of the Original Applications declining the prayer for regularization of services of the applicants. We however observe that, in case the Respondents propose to fill the posts/vacancies against which the applicants are working, the cases of the applicants shall also be considered in terms of Recruitment Rules duly verifying the educational qualifications. However, the applicants shall not be replaced by another set of temporary employees."

The applicants have challenged the orders of this Tribunal dt. 12.04.2019 before the Hon'ble High Court by filing writ petitions. The Hon'ble High Court allowed the writ petitions and observed as under:

"10. For the aforesaid reasons, the Writ Petitions are allowed, setting aside the orders, dated 12.04.2019 passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal, Hyderabad Bench, Hyderabad in Original Application Nos.432, 434, 436, 438, 439, 1066, 1077, 1108, 1109 and 1068 of 2015 and the said Original Applications stand restored to the file of the Tribunal for fresh consideration of the issue, with reference to observations made supra, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Till the disposal of these Original Applications, status quo as on today with regard to the status of the petitioners herein shall be maintained. There shall be no order as to costs of the Writ Petitions."

As per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court, this Tribunal is re-hearing the matter considering all aspects of the case.
