Order of The Tribunal

Heard Sri T.P. Acharya, learned counsel for the applicant.

2. Sri K. Ajay Kumar, learned Standing Counsel has accepted notice on behalf of the respondents and advanced his arguments.

3. Sri T.P. Acharya, learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant was appointed as TGT (Sanskrit) in 2002. He has been working in Kendriya Vidyalaya No.1, Uppal, Hyderabad since 2019. Now, the applicant has been transferred to Suryalanka AFS, A.P. vide impugned transfer order dated 13.09.2022. It is argued by the learned counsel for the applicant that the applicant has been transferred in derogation of Transfer Guidelines of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan 2021. Further, the wife of the applicant is working in Hyderabad. It is submitted that the applicant has not been relieved so far and no substitute has been posted in his place. Learned counsel for the applicant has prayed for suspension of the impugned transfer order till the O.A. is

finalized.

4. Sri K. Ajay Kumar, learned Standing Counsel for KVS has submitted that the impugned transfer order has been issued for the purpose of rationalization and redistribution of existing teaching staff, and in order to ensure that at least 50% of regular teaching staff are available in all KVs across the country. He has opposed for grant of interim relief and requested for four weeks' time for filing reply.

5. After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, this Tribunal is of the opinion that prima facie, the applicant has made out a case for grant of interim relief and the balance of convenience lies in favour of him. Therefore, the impugned transfer order dated 13.09.2022 is suspended till the next date of hearing in so far as the applicant is concerned.

6. Respondents are granted four weeks' time for filing reply. List the matter on 01.11.2022.
