16/02/2021	Mr. Goutam Khetrapal, Advocate for the Petitioner. Mr. Rahul Jha, Govt. Advocate for the State. Heard on I.A. No.3, which is an application for amendment in the writ petition. Not opposed. The said application accordingly stands allowed. Let necessary amendment be carried out during the course of the day itself and the amended writ petition also be brought on record. The State counsel would accept notice on behalf of all the respondents, hence issuance of notice stands dispensed with. Considering the fact that the petitioner stands retired from service w.e.f. 31.07.2020 and the fact that the notice of recovery has been issued just a couple of day before his retirement and also the impugned order does not verify as to how the respondents reach to the conclusion of the excess amount amounting to more than Rs.6 lakhs, prima-facie a strong case for grant of interim relief has been made out. Accordingly, there shall
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be a stay of the effect and operation of the impugned orders Annexure P/1 & P/11 dated 05.11.2020 & 27.10.2020 respectively till the next date of hearing.

Let reply be filed within a period of 6 weeks and the matter be listed for hearing in the week commencing 19th of April, 2021.
