12/04/2022	Heard Mr. N.K. Chatterjee, learned counsel for the appellants. Also heard Mr. Vikram Sharma, learned Deputy Government Advocate, appearing for respondent No. 1, Mr. C. Jayant K. Rao, learned counsel, appearing for respondent No.3 and Mr. Keshav Prasad Gupta, learned counsel, appearing for respondent No. 4. Notice to respondent No. 2 was sent by the registered post with A/D on 24.12.2021 in WA No. 28 of 2021. Having regard to the period of time that has elapsed after dispatch of notice by registered post with A/D, notice on respondent No. 2 is deemed to be served. It is also relevant to take note of fact that in the order of this Court dated 17.09.2021, passed in Writ Appeal Nos. 27 of 2021 and 28 of 2021 that 'Ayush Medical Association Chhattisgarh and Bilaspur Homeopathic Chikitsa Sangh' have already been served the notice issued by this Court on 28.01.2021.
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I.A. No. 1 of 2021 in both the appeals are applications for condonation of delay of 29 days in preferring the connected appeals against the order dated 28.10.2020 passed in Writ Petition (S) Nos. 3961 of 2020 and 3962 of 2020.

The appellants in both the cases had filed application for intervention before the learned Single Judge. However, it is submitted by Mr. Chatterjee that no order was passed on such application and the writ petition came to be disposed of.

The appellants have filed an application for leave to appeal being I.A. No. 5 of 2021 in Writ Appeal No. 27 of 2021 and I.A. No. 4 of 2021 in Writ Appeal No. 28 of 2021.

The applications for condonation of delay and applications for leave to appeal is not opposed.

On consideration of materials on record and on hearing the learned counsel for the parties, after condoning the delay, leave to appeal is granted.

The above I.As are disposed of.
